## ARTICLE 9 PUBLICATION OF LISTS

The list of valid candidacies must be published at least three five working days before the elections.

The order of the names on each list must correspond to the order in which the names appear on the respective list that was submitted by each trade union or professional organisation or independent group of eligible officials and other servants.

The lists of candidacies must indicate the statutory status of the candidates (officials or other servants) And, for the officials, the function group.

## ARTICLE 14 VOTING PROCESS

The voting date is set by the General Assembly.

The priority voting method is by electronic vote. Paper ballot is only possible if the Administration cannot guarantee an electronic voting system.

- 1. For three working days, the voting staff may vote according to the Notice of Election, either in the Election stations that will be provided for this purpose or electronically by electronic vote or, if not possible, by paper ballots.
- 2. The voters who have an impediment (e.g. mission, leave ...) to vote on the election days have the right to vote by correspondence.
- 3. The Electoral Office will determine the method of voting by correspondence; this shall appear in the notice of election. In case of voting by correspondence, the ballot must arrive at the president of the Electoral Office before the voting closing date.
- 4. If, three days after the voting, the quorum of two-thirds of those with voting right is not achieved, the voting period is extended ex officio by ten working days. In case of ballot voting, two physical Election stations will be open during this period.

## **FINAL TRANSITIONAL PROVISIONS**

In the voting methods, the Electoral Office may also introduce electronic voting, after the competent services of the Commission have confirmed that this could take place in compliance with the security measures and the principle of confidentiality.

In no case may the possible procedure of electronic voting determine the change of the date that has been set for the voting. Electronic voting cannot be included in the voting methods at the next elections of the CLP.
